UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. It was orally mentioned by the learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioner and Mr. Tushar Mehta, learned Solicitor General appearing for the Union of India stating that by virtue of the present order passed by the High Court of Delhi, there is every possibility that Indian athletes might lose the chance of participating in international events, including the Olympics.

2. It has been further stated that if the impugned order is allowed to operate, it would be not in the best interest of the nation.

3. We are informed that charge of the Indian Olympics Association has not been handed over to the Committee of Administrators so far.

4. In view of the serious concerns raised in the matter, we direct the parties to maintain status-quo.

5. List the matter on Monday, the 22nd August, 2022 before an appropriate bench.
